Portosystemic Shunt research



History



- Already in 2001 puppies with Portosystemic shunts
- Several different breeding lines (about 30) found in the last 17 years
- Almost every year a new case
 - Often not a breeding line known as being at risk
- Now and then we get information about a puppy with shunt from abroad.
- In 2015 decision to screen for the prevalence of this disease
 - Because of impact for the owner
 - So many different breeding lines



Research



Goal:

- To find out whether the prevalence is higher than 1% of the population
- Collect blood and material for the research of Frank van Steenbeek

Test:

1000 puppies tested at 7 weeks of age

Results up to now

- Tested since 1–1–2016: +/_ 550 puppies
- 1 puppy with a portosystemic shunt (not a breeding line at risk)

What to do at the end of the research

 The VBSH will have to decide if the test will be an obligation or an advice when a litter is born.
